1. **Abuse and Neglect**
  - Physical abuse

1. **Health and Disability**

  - Sudden disability (accident or illness)
  - Mental health disorders
2. **Relationship Challenges**
  - Divorce or breakup
  - Domestic abuse or violence
  - Infidelity
3. **Loss and Grief**
  - Death of a loved one
  - Miscarriage or infertility
  - Loss of a pet
4. **Economic Hardships**
  - Unemployment or job instability
